EARLY BIRDS (Blue sheet) 2 lines anyway, 5 #'s will be called 1 under each letter (BINGO) players must bingo on one of these numbers to win the jackpot, \$50 will be added to the accumulator jackpot every week, consolation will be 40% of sales. Jackpot starts at \$500.

LETTER "E" SPECIAL (Brown) The right way, prize is 50% of ticket sales. Jackpot accumulates \$50 each event. Players must bingo in 40 #'s or less to win accumulator jackpot. Jackpot starts at \$500.

LIME	5.	One line or 4 corners	50.00
	6.	Two lines anyway or One line and 4 corners	50.00
PEACH	7.	One outside line	50.00
	8.	Two outside lines	50.00

TRIANGLE (Violet) Shaded side only, starts in 28 #'s, jackpot accumulates 30% of sales and one number is added each event. Consolation 40% of tickets sales. Jackpot starts at \$500.

INTERMISSION

DIAMOND (Purple sealed card) Prize 50% of ticket sales.

BROWN	11.	Letter T anyway	50.00

BONANZA (Gold sealed card) Pre-call 48 numbers, accumulator to be won in 52 #'s or less, consolation prize 40% of ticket sales, 30% of sales will be added per event. Jackpot starts at \$1,000.

LUCKY 7 (Aqua) Prize is 50% of ticket sales

NAVY	14.	One line up and down (play loonie sheet)	50.00

LETTER Y (Red) The letter Y the right way. Prize is 50% of ticket sales.

HOUSE RULES

1. House rules: no one under the age of 12 allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
2. Anyone occupying a seat must play **BINGO**.
3. Players are responsible to check booklets before they start to play - 10 pages per book.
4. Booklet/sheets must be marked by a dabber. Number must not be obliterated.
5. A regular game book must be purchased to be eligible for any and all special games including early bird game.
6. Special games shall be paid out a % of special game book sales, as listed.
7. House is not responsible for lost cards.
8. Player must call BINGO loud enough to stop play. Call and raise your hand **NO** bingo will be acknowledged after a game is declared closed.
9. In case of multiple winners, cash payout will be divided equally, minimum \$5.00.
10. House reserves the right to pay winners by cheque.
11. When bingo has been called no further numbers are called. If the caller has a ball in hand and bingo has been called that number is not a called number for the game. If caller has started the letter part of the ball, the caller must continue to call the ball.
12. Bonanza – pre-call 48 numbers at 12:15 pm, accumulator to be won in 52 numbers or less, 40% consolation prize. Pot starts at \$1,000.00, 30% of sales will be added per event.
13. Loonie Jackpot – 50% of sales shall accumulate. First # called excluding the N's on Early Bird game shall be the Loonie # for the event. Loonie game is played with the navy regular game book sheet. Loonie jackpot can be won once per event- on the regular games only.
14. House reserves the right to refuse entrance.
15. House reserves the right to cancel event due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances.
16. Bingo workers, except caller, are allowed to play bingo.

BREAK OPEN TICKETS

All winning tickets must be cashed in the same day as purchased.
No person under the age of 18 may purchase break open tickets.
Seller may not purchase break open tickets at the same event they are working.
