INGREDIENTS

Yield: 3+ dozen cookies (depending on size of cutter)

1 cup light brown sugar
 1 cup light molasses
 1 cup butter or vegetable shortening (1/2 cup butter & 1/2 cup coconut oil works well too!)
 1 tablespoon baking soda
 1 egg, lightly beaten
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 2 teaspoons baking powder
 1 tablespoon ground ginger
 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
 4 to 4 1/2 cups all-purpose flour, more for rolling dough
 Decorate with Royal icing and cinnamon candies (optional)

PREPARATIONS

STEP 1

In a large saucepan, combine brown sugar, molasses and shortening. Place over medium-low heat and stir just until mixture is melted and smooth. Remove from heat and mix in baking soda and 1/4 cup cold water. Set aside and allow to cool to room temperature.

STEP 2

Add egg, salt, baking powder, ginger, cinnamon and cloves; stir to mix well. Add 4 cups flour and mix well, adding up to 1/2 cup more if dough seems sticky. Shape into a ball, cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hrs (to 24 hrs.)

STEP 3

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Line baking sheets with parchment paper and set aside.

On a lightly floured surface, roll out dough 1/4-inch thickness, (or less... they really puff up and spread!) and cut into gingerbread boy or other shapes.

Arrange on baking sheets 2 inches apart, and bake about 6-10 minutes (puffy and no longer shiny ~ the longer you leave in, the crispier the cookies.) Remove from heat and baking sheet, allow cookies to cool.

If desired, decorate with royal icing and cinnamon candies.

Store in an airtight container.
