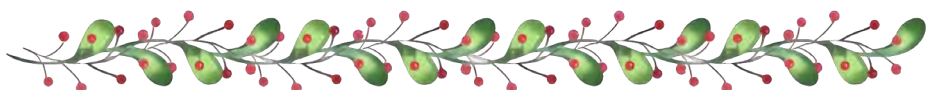

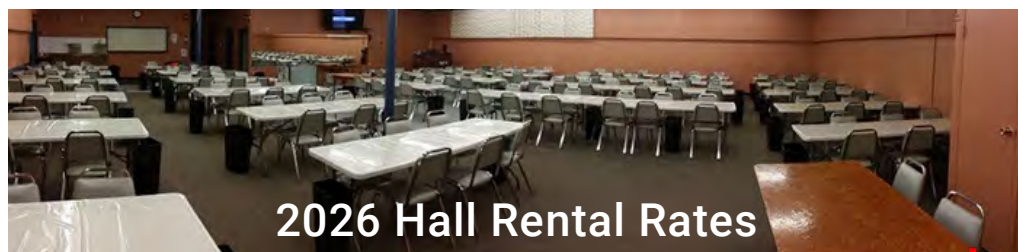
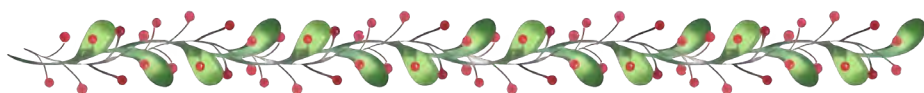

This rate applies to non business hours only. Members may use the lounge for events free of charge during normal business hours. The understanding being that other members or patrons may also be in the lounge.

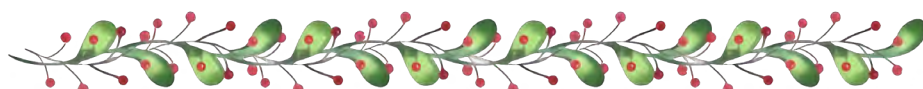
Damage Deposit remains at \$400.00

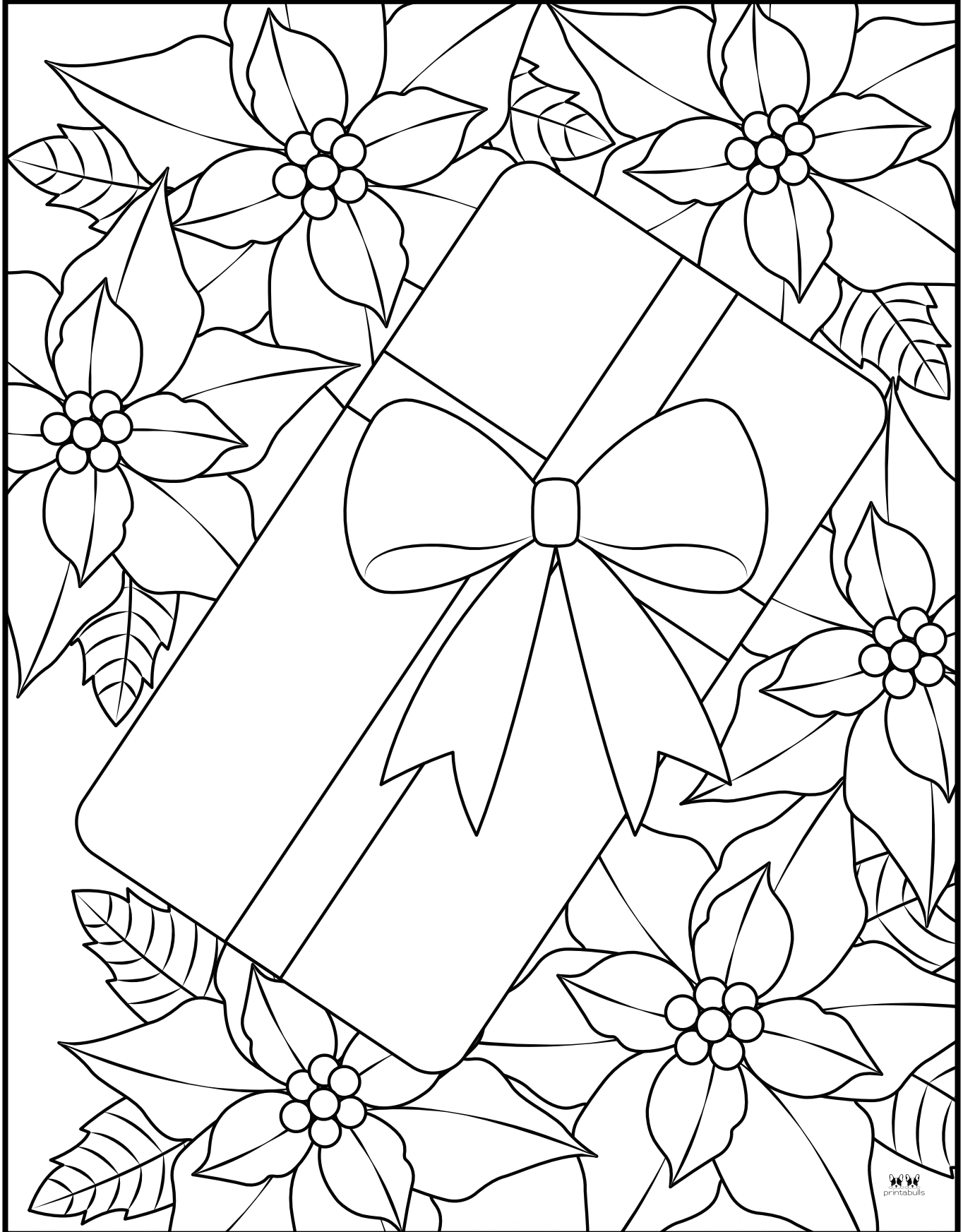

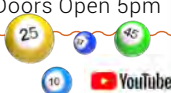
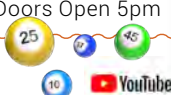
